Board Chair's Report</u> Dr. Vanterpool reported that she attended the National Board of Chiropractic Examiners (NBCE) meeting held at Palmer College, the original chiropractic school in the United States. The meeting was held in Davenport, Iowa in November 2015. Dr. Vanterpool also reported that she attended the Federation of Chiropractic Licensing Boards (FCLB) District III Board of Directors meeting in January 2016. The meeting was held in Las Vegas, Nevada. Dr. Vanterpool announced that she will officially run for the incumbent District III Director position with FCLB. Dr. Vanterpool stated that she will attend the National Chiropractic Legislative Conference (NCLC) which will be held in the District of Columbia in February 2016 and the FCLB Annual Conference which will be held in Phoenix, Arizona in April 2016. B. Executive Director's Report

Robin Jenkins reported that the position for the Board of Chiropractic executive director has been re-posted with the following new requirements;

- To be posted until filled
- Medical Doctor (MD) preferred

Ms. Jenkins stated that she will continue to serve as interim executive director for the board until the position is filled.

Ms. Jenkins reported that the legislation for the Lesbian, Gay, Bi-Sexual, Transgender, & Queer (LGBTQ) continuing education requirement was passed by the District of Columbia Council. All health professionals will be required to complete 2 hours of LGBTQ continuing education (CE) in competency and treatment. She stated that this regulatory change will apply to all boards.

Ms. Jenkins reported that Councilmember Yvette Alexander's committee on health will hold an Oversight Hearing for the Health Regulation & Licensing Administration (HURLA) on February 17, 2016. Dr. Lewis has asked that respective Board chair persons attend and testify on the activity of the board. Ms. Jenkins stated that the Department of Health (DOH) Performance Hearing will be held on February 19, 2016.

Ms. Jenkins reported the following BOC census; there are currently 101 active licensees of which 74 have privileges in ancillary procedures.
